



THE LINKS VOUCHER SYSTEM

The Links has initiated a voucher system for the convenience of both players, and the club. Players can either purchase vouchers using an EFT or pay upfront in cash, and in return will receive the applicable number of vouchers in a plastic folder.



The directors will collect the vouchers on their rounds, as if it were cash.

Our computer system will perform certain administrative functions:

- When an EFT is received the date and amount will be logged.
- The system will print vouchers using your SABF number and name as references.
- When the voucher is used to pay for a tournament it will be recorded.
- Each voucher is numbered. If vouchers are lost the system can reprint the remaining unused vouchers.
- If someone tries to re-use a voucher the system will reject it to prevent possible fraud.
- After each tournament, the system will send an email to the players who used a voucher that day. The email will indicate the date played and also list the number and details of the vouchers remaining for the player.
- The number of vouchers you purchase is unlimited with a minimum requirement of four.
